Re-entry Update: Phase II

Parents and Guardians:

With your patience and support, the Copiah County School District has experienced a healthy and successful start to the school year. As a district, we are prepared to move on to Phase II of our reopening plan. We realize the majority of our students learn best in a face-to-face environment, and it is our goal to have all students on campus as soon as we can safely do so.

On Wednesday, September 23rd, all students in grades K – 8 will return to a traditional method of instruction. These students will attend school from Monday through Thursday on a regular school day schedule. On Friday, students will be released at 1:30 PM. We will continue to follow our safety procedures to ensure a safe environment for our students.

The students in grades 9-12 will continue to attend school on a hybrid schedule until further notice. Details for high school campus reentry will be given at a later date. Those students across the district who are currently attending virtually will continue using the virtual platform for the remainder of the 9 weeks. Please continue to check the district and school websites for new information.

We ask parents to continue to be flexible and prepared to change from our regular schedule should conditions change. Our administration will continue to follow the advice of the Mississippi Department of Health and the Mississippi Department of Education going forward, and we will continue to make updates as needed.
